During New International Student Week, **we welcomed 16 new international students** from 11 countries (Brazil, Egypt, Israel, Japan, Kenya, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Thailand, Turkey, and Vietnam). They will be joining the approximately 340 current international students (from about 65 countries) for Winter 2021. -- Many more students have applied but have had to defer to a future term because of the current COVID situation. We are keeping in contact with them, and we hope to welcome them in the coming year.

Last week, **SEVP provided an update** and confirmed that F-1 students will be able to continue to maintain their status in the same way as Fall 2020 (see brief <u>article</u> in Inside Higher Ed). This is good news for international students who already have I-20s in active status. It is, however, not great news for students with I-20s in initial status outside the US because they are (generally) not able to enter the country if their college/program is fully online.
