FINANCE YOUR STUDY

We are very affordable with tuition at \$10,000 USD per year. All F-1 international students must provide documentation of \$25,800 USD in order to be admitted. Here are estimated minimum expenses for an academic year (3 terms/9 months) for a student taking 12 credits per term. Actual expenses may vary. Tuition and fees are subject to change.

While studying at PCC, students are eligible for:

- Partial scholarships
- Part-time jobs on-campus
- Tuition payment plans

SUPPORT

The Office of International Student Services provides student support, visa advising, and international student life and activities. Additionally, each PCC student is assigned an academic advisor to help create an education plan.

HOUSING

PCC does not have on-campus housing, but there are many options located very close to our campuses. Students can choose between apartments or homestays.
