Re: Internationalization Grant Report

Thank you for the opportunity to develop curriculum for a WR 227 Professional and Technical Writing course that focuses on a cross-cultural comparison of bicycle urbanism.

To develop new curriculum, I reviewed the Portland Bureau of Transportation's Bicycle Plan for 2030; consulted with PCC librarian Jennifer Rogers to discuss the best strategies for researching bicycle urbanism in model cities throughout the world; and wrote 10 new writing assignments to support the new curriculum (attached as a separate zip file).

Most of my time was spent writing the new assignments. As you know, I proposed that students would create researched powerpoint presentations that focus on different model bicycle cities around the world. Students would then examine the City of Portland's own bicycle infrastructure and public policy, writing recommendation reports supported by their cross cultural research.

Both the powerpoint and the recommendation report assignments required scaffolding, so I wrote three assignments to support the researched powerpoint assignment (Project 1) and seven assignments to support the recommendation report (Project 2).
