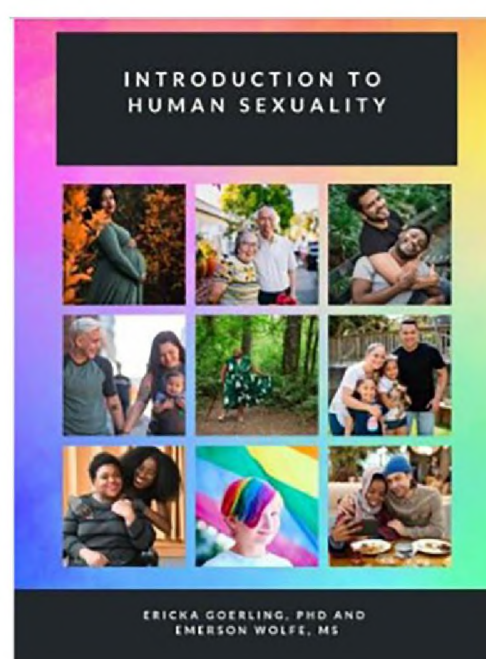
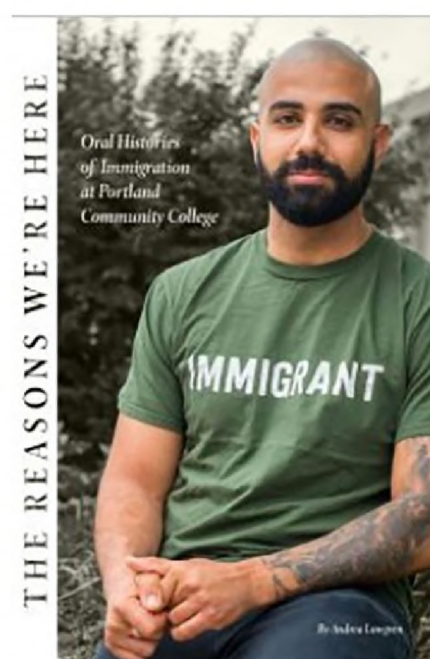
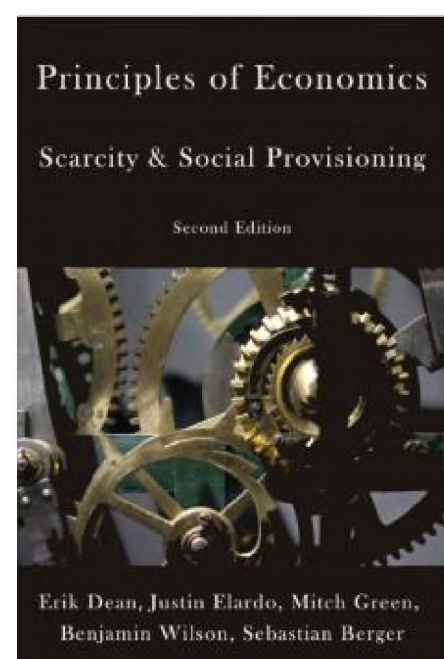

# PCC Open Educational Resources (OER) by the numbers



- OER & alternative course materials have saved PCC students over **\$30 million since 2017**
- PCC instructors have authored over **23 complete, free, OER textbooks** through Open Oregon grants, and more will be published soon!

- **104** PCC faculty participated in Equity and Open Education cohorts
  - **98%** say it helped make high-impact changes to their teaching
- 24% of PCC courses use low or \$0 cost course materials (on average)







# Student Voices

We asked PCC students, what would it mean for you if your classes used free or low cost course materials instead of high cost textbooks?

*“Because of the price of class materials I have to hold down two jobs and go to school full-time. Sometimes I don't know how I keep going.”*

*“I would get better grades and more knowledge because I would actually get the books instead of just checking them out at the library when I need them.”*

*“If materials were free or low-cost I would be able to pay to take more classes instead of having to spend that money on materials.”*
