

Program of Study Plan

- 1) Content and Standards
 - The skill sets used will be from the ODE Visual and Performing Arts skill sets
 - Using P.C.C. content and standards
- 2) Alignment and Articulation
 - One course has been articulated with P.C.C. and will be reviewed for continued articulation.
 - The program of study will be aligned with community college and four year college program/majors in visual and performing arts.
 - Instructor will work with the community college to insure alignment with its multimedia/visual arts academic programs.
- 3) Assessment and Evaluation
 - Instructor will work with advisory community to evaluate goal and content and adjust as necessary.
 - Program will be evaluated by instructor and administrators using the criteria of student participation, student performance evaluation, student knowledge and skill sets as demonstrated through student portfolio.
- 4) Student Support Services
 - Instructor will use Synergy software to review student needs and communicate with case manager what modifications and accommodations will be needed and will adjust as needed.
 - Career and Guidance Counselors will be made aware of this new program of study and will provide information to all student regarding courses available and desired outcomes.
 - Forest Grove students do explore future career pathways using Oregon CIS prior to and during high school.
 - Instructor will work with ELL specialist to provide support for all ELL students in the program.
 - Student recruitment will be conducted through performances for Middle School students at the Middle School, a booth presence at Middle School Parent Night and other activities.
- 5) Professional Development
 1. At least once or twice a year meet with other high school and community college teachers to determine alignment and possible articulation.
 2. Instructor will attend an ACTE conference to review and explore CTE resources.
 3. Instructor will continue to take additional classes/ workshops in Multimedia and Visual and Performance Arts.

Sustainability

Initial Perkins funding will be used to purchase multimedia equipment, update facilities to enhance program viability, video production programs and computer and green screen. Long term funding would come from schools general funds, receipts from performances, fundraising and various events which will be managed by advanced students. Measure 98 funding.
