This entry-level, 60-hour, two-week intensive training introduces you to mass timber, an emerging industry in the Pacific Northwest. BEAM provides hands-on skills development, industry exposure, and insight into career opportunities.

After successful completion, participants earn a PCC Trades Safety Micro-credential which includes OSHA 10, First Aid/CPR, and Forklift certification.

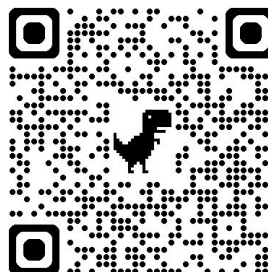
