

Approved Healthcare Certifications for the PCC Radiography Program

The following list shows current healthcare certifications that have been approved by the Medical Imaging Department.* Only by uploading the required supporting documentation to the program application prior to the application deadline, will you be awarded points.

Note: This list gets updated once a year. To get current information, we encourage you to meet with an academic advisor in the Healthcare & Emergency Professions (HEP) pathway or with a Career Services Practitioner.

As a reminder, for the 2024 application cycle, to gain points for Healthcare Experience/Certification in a Medical Setting the applicant must follow these parameters outlined on page 7 of the Admissions Guide:

Healthcare Experience/Certification in a Medical Setting (choose ONE of the following experiences)

All experience must take place in a medical setting with direct patient contact. A medical setting is a hospital, clinic, nursing home or other environment where licensed practitioners diagnose, treat, and prevent acute and chronic illness or injury. If using a license or certification to gain points, copies of license or certification must be uploaded with your application to qualify for points.

Healthcare Experience/Certification Total Points Possible	/10 pts
Minimum of 300 hours of demonstrated paid work experience in an in- patient imaging department. Examples include radiography aide, radiography transporter, radiography scheduler, or radiography assistant.	/10 pts
Minimum of 200 hours documented, post certification, work experience.	/ 8 pts
Minimum of 100 hours documented volunteer or work experience.	/ 6 pts
