



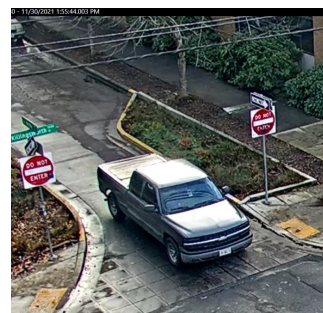

### CRIME ALERT

**PCC Case #21-0134**



Portland Community College (PCC) Public Safety is seeking assistance in identifying a person who stole the catalytic converter from a student's car while it was parked on campus.

On Tuesday, November 30, 2021, at approximately 12:50 pm, an unknown male driving the Chevrolet pickup depicted in the above photos, drove into PCC Cascade Campus Parking Lot 3, parked next to a student's car, then crawled under the student's car and cut off the catalytic converter. The male subject then left the area driving westbound on N Killingsworth away from PCC Cascade. The male was described to a PCC staff member as a white male, unknown age range, unknown height and/or weight, and unknown clothing description. The male was seen driving a grey, 2-door, mid 2000's, Chevrolet pickup with tinted windows, custom 7 spoke rims, and a black tonneau cover over the bed of the pickup. The pickup has a large dent in the right rear quarter panel near the cab and a smoke colored tinted license plate cover.
