### ADDITIONAL REQUIRED MATERIALS

- Kneaded eraser

- Palette with wells (the link is to a ceramic palette – but a cheap plastic one is fine!)

- Graphite paper (at least 9" by 12")

- Pipette or eyedropper

- Board (we'll be taping our paper to boards so that we can paint using easels)
  - Any board larger than 9" x 12". Art stores including Artist and Craftsman sell a product called "Coroplast" (corrugated plastic) that works well
  - Other great options: corkboard (use thumbtacks to attach paper), magnetic board (use magnets)
- Pencil (Regular #2 pencil is fine)
- Blue painter's tape (or other easily removed tape such as washi tape)
- Washcloth (for blotting brush)
- Ballpoint pen (for transferring image from graphite paper onto Bristol paper)
