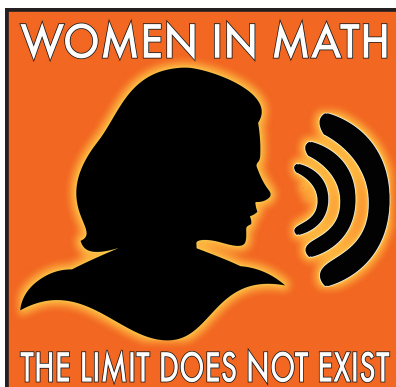


## WimLimDNE Extra Credit



When you think of a mathematician, what do you think of? It turns out, most people think of an old, white, Caucasian man. This is due to a lot of cultural and societal factors, but this is not an accurate portrayal of mathematicians.

*Women in Math: The Limit Does Not Exist* is a podcast facilitated by Damien Adams that serves to promote the visibility of women in mathematics in the past and present in hopes to change this mental image as we move to the future.

### What do you need to do?

1. Go to the podcast at <http://www.tinyurl.com/wimlimdnepodcast> and listen to TWO episodes: a **biography** and a **conversation**.
  - Listen to a biography (the title will just be a woman's name).  
These episodes include episodes 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 12, 13, 14, 19, 20, 21, 23, 24, 25, 29, 30, 31, 37, and 39.
  - ALSO listen to a conversation (the title will begin with "A Conversation Between...").  
These episodes include episodes 2, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16, 17, 18, 22, 26, 28, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, and 38.
2. Once you listen to these episodes, write a one-page long response, detailing how you feel about the podcast. You might ask yourself if you feel inspired, if this changes your views on women in mathematics, if this reinforces how you feel, if you thought this was a waste of time, or even if you want to participate yourself. This extra credit assignment is meant to be open-ended, and you may respond however you like.

This assignment is worth 5 points and is due the first meeting of the week before finals week.
