## as...as, not as...as, less...than

### Grammar Tip

<b>as + adjective + as</b>	is used to show that two things are the same.
<b>not as + adjective + as</b>	is used to show that two things are different.
<b>less + adjective + than</b>	is used to show things are different using an adjective that is two syllables or more (except two syllable adjectives that end in -y).
*Do not use less + adjective + than with one syllable adjectives.
