
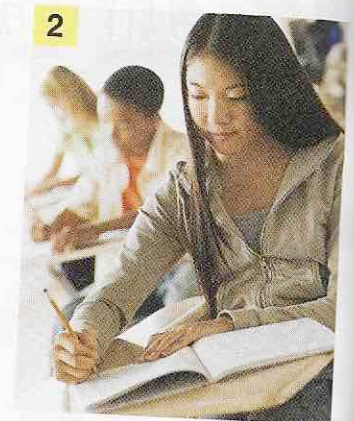
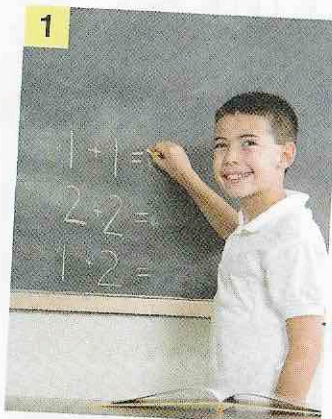

A WORD PLAY. PAIRS. Choose a school subject from the vocabulary list. Don't tell your partner. Write three clues for the word. Your partner will guess the word.

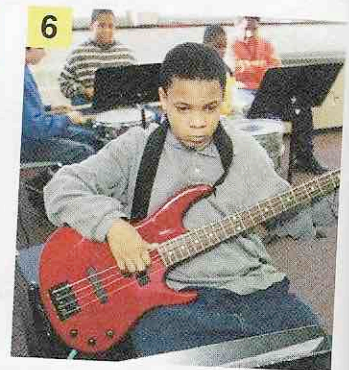

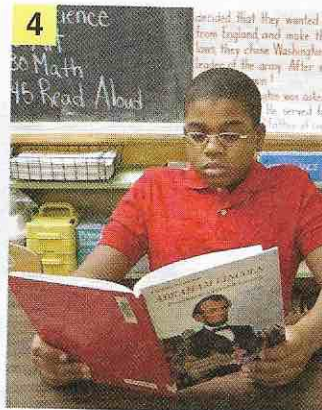

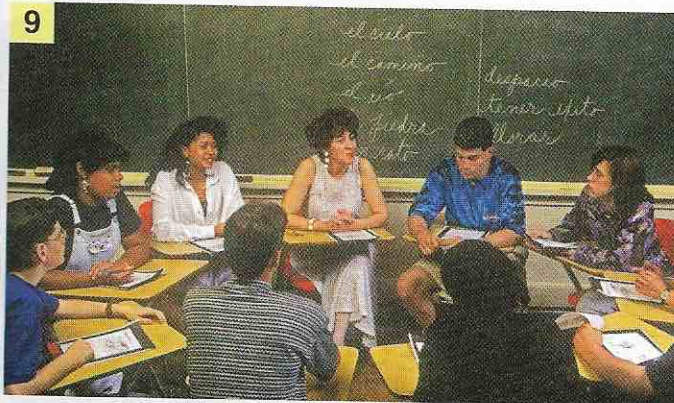
