Intro to Tapestry Weaving: Supply List:

The following is a list of items you will need to bring to class:

- 1. notebook for taking notes, and pencil
- 2. ruler or sewing tape measure
- 3. a large dinner/serving fork (to use as a weft beater) 4 tines
- 4. an assortment of yarns (if you don't have a *bag o' yarn*, Goodwill or Scrap can be a good place to look)
- 5. scissors
- 6. sturdy flat picture frame or stretcher bars (not for the first class we will talk about this): suggested dimensions 18' x 24"
- 7. a paint stick or similar smooth wooden lath to use as a shed stick (again, not for the first class)

Be sure you bring the first 5 items listed above to our first meeting.
