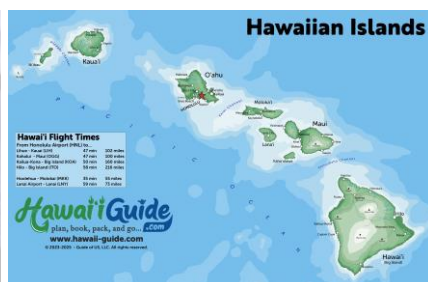


HAWAII
