1. to say what someone or something is. Example: I am a student. / This is an Android phone.
2. to describe someone or something. Example: I am nervous. / My books are new. / Chicago is big.
3. to talk about where someone or something is. Example: I am in class. / The book is on the table.
4. to talk about where someone is from. Example: I am from Mexico. / They are from Vietnam.
5. to talk about age. Example: I am 25 years old. / Her son is five years old.
6. with it to talk about weather or time. Examples: It is cold and rainy. / It is 9:30. / It is Friday.
