Example	Rules (Explanation)
1. play → plays	Add -s to most verbs
2. wash → washes	When a verb ends in s, sh, ch, or x , add -es
3. study → studies	When a verb ends in a consonant + y , no y , add -ies
4. go → goes	When a verb ends in o , add -es
5. have → has	Remember
