

## Alternative Transportation Options at PCC

### Take the Shuttle!

- PCC has a free shuttle service for students and staff that runs during the Fall, Winter, and Spring terms.



### Use Public Transit!

- Tri-Met has several lines serving each PCC campus or center.

### Bike it!

- There are bike racks located on all campuses and PCC Centers and there are locker rooms and showers available at most campuses. The hours vary depending on school activities and breaks. Looking for someone to bike to PCC with? You can use drive less connect to find someone whose route is similar to yours!

### Carpool!

- PCC has partnered with METRO, the state of Oregon and the state of Washington to offer a new transportation matching system called Drive Less Connect that lets you find other PCC goers with similar routes and times to carpool with!

### Use a Car Share Program!

- Car Sharing is a short-term car rental agreement where you pay by the minute, hour, or day depending on the program and the rate includes your insurance (some also include gas). The three most frequently used by Portlanders are: Zipcar, Car2Go, and Getaround. If you choose to drive a Zipcar or a Car2Go to a PCC Campus, you will not need a parking permit. Car2go will also have a designated spot at Cascade, Sylvania and Southeast.
