PAPER NEWSPAPER MAGAZINES

- Paper of all colors (tape, staples, glue, paper clips are okay)
- Envelopes (windows and labels are okay)
- Spiral-bound notebooks
- File folders
- Phone books
- Milk cartons (empty and rinsed)



- Coffee cups
- Label-backing sheets
- Frozen food boxes
- Bath tissue
- Paper towels
- Paper plates
- Waxed cardboard boxes



• Flattened cardboard boxes



- Wax-coated cardboard
- Take-out food containers
- Pizza boxes

- **PLASTIC TUBS PLASTIC BOTTLES** (empty and rinse)
- Yogurt-type containers (6 oz or larger)
- Jugs and jars with a threaded neck
- Buckets (5 gallons or smaller)



- Plastic bags
- Lids
- To-go cups
- Take-out food containers

- **METAL CANS FOIL**
- (empty and rinse)
- Aluminum cans
- Tin cans
- Steel food cans
- Remove all food from foil and crumple into loosely-packed balls





- Do not flatten
- Do not include lids (unless they are attached to cans)



Recycle Separately

GLASS

- Recycle glass bottles and jars in a separate container
- Do not include lightbulbs, drinking glasses, or dishware



AEROSOL CANS

• Place an SRC request for aerosol can recycling



ELECTRONICS

- Place a Surplus Request for pick-up
- For PCC property only do not include personal electronics or appliances



BATTERIES

- Request a battery disposal bucket
- Place SRC request when full



SCRAP METAL

- Place a Surplus Request for pick-up
- Do not include metal that has plastic, food, or other non-metal materials attached



SHREDDED PAPER

- Place in clear plastic bag
- Place an SRC request for pick-up
- Do not place loose in recycling container
