Paint: Purchasing Interior/Exterior Architectural Paint Products

All facilities painting should be coordinated through [Facilities Management Services Project Development and Construction](#). FMS works to use low-VOC (volatile organic chemical) paints that comply with the current standards set forth by the California South Coast Air Quality Management rule 1113 for Architectural coatings. FMS also gives preference to recycled and/or re-blended latex paints with low-VOC properties. General Paint and Primer to be Greenguard Gold Certified and low or no VOC.
