

# LEVELS OF INTEGRATION OF ETHNIC CONTENT


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### Mainstream Centric Curriculum



## Level 1: The Contributions Approach

The focus is on heroes, holidays, and discrete cultural elements.





## Level 2: The Additive Approach

 Content, concepts, themes, and perspectives are added to the curriculum without changing its structure.





### Level 3: The Transformation Approach

The structure of the curriculum is changed to enable students to view concepts, issues, events, and themes from the perspective of diverse ethnic and cultural

groups.



# Level 4: The Social Action Approach

 Students make decisions on important social issues and take action to help solve them.
