OTHER****	Other technical skill assessment	The technical skill assessment does not fit into any other category.
PAIRCL****	Performance assessment with industry recognized certificate or license	One or more tasks or work samples are evaluated using a standard rubric. Development and scoring is controlled by a national or state organization that awards industry recognized credentials for demonstrated proficiency.
PAXNOCLI***	Performance assessment developed and scored externally (no certificate or license)	One or more tasks or work samples are evaluated using a standard rubric. Development and scoring is controlled by a national or state assessment provider that does <b>not</b> award an industry recognized credential for demonstrated proficiency.
PALOC****	Performance assessment developed and scored locally	One or more tasks or work samples are evaluated using a standard rubric. Development and scoring is controlled by a regional or local agency or organization.
TESTIRCL**	Test with industry recognized certificate or license	A standardized test or set of tests that are developed and scored by a national or state organization that awards industry recognized credentials for demonstrated proficiency.
TESTXNOCL*	Test developed and scored externally (no certificate or license)	A standardized test or tests that are developed and scored by a national or state assessment provider that does <b>not</b> award industry recognized credentials for demonstrated proficiency.
TESTLOC***	Test developed and scored locally	A standardized test or tests that are developed and scored by a regional or local agency or organization.
PORTIRCL**	Portfolio with industry recognized certificate or license	A collection of evidence which may include performance

		assessments and tests. The portfolio is assessed using a rubric developed and controlled by a national or state organization that awards industry recognized credentials for demonstrated proficiency.
PORTXNOCL*	Portfolio scored externally (no certificate or license)	A collection of evidence which may include performance assessments and tests. The portfolio is assessed using a rubric developed and controlled by a national or state assessment provider that does <b>not</b> award industry recognized credentials for proficiency.
PORTLOC***	Portfolio scored locally	A collection of evidence which may include performance assessments and tests. The portfolio criteria development and evaluation is conducted by a local or regional agency or organization.
