

IT Portfolio Quarter Analysis Report October 2023 - December 2023

Summary

At the conclusion of fall term, the Information Technology Portfolio has remained stable and healthy. The IT project teams did a great job delivering a diverse range of technology projects and closed 17 projects. Of these, 16 were completed successfully, while one was canceled at clients' request. Quarterly average project closures have decreased slightly by three projects compared to the same period last year. See page 2 for detailed information. We also received 10 new project requests which were seven requests fewer than the project intakes in FY23 Fall.

Current IT Portfolio Assessment

Projects in the portfolio are looking quite promising and positioned the organization well for success this fiscal year. Majority of projects are in good standing.

At the start of winter term, the IT Portfolio has 86 projects with the following health status:

- 40 green projects in a good standing. 9 projects that are over 90% completed.
- 9 yellow projects have documented issues
- 0 red projects at risk.
- 21 on hold projects are on hold due to resources constraints.
- 4 backlog projects are approved but not started yet.

On Gaining Partners and Collaborations

- Engagement with clients and key stakeholders is progressing positively, fostering collaboration and communication.
- Quarterly Community of Practice Portfolio Project Management open forum has been moving forward and has seen notable improvement.


