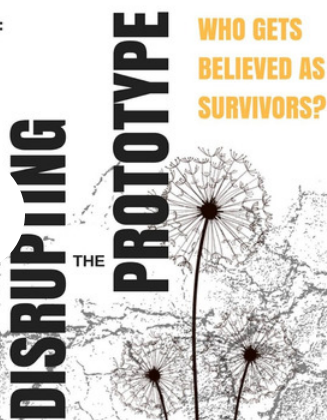
PSU's Take Back the Night
