How many PCC students receive PELL grants? What is the graduation rate of PCC students?

What percent of credit students are males enrolled full-time?

The "College Navigator" tool enables students, potential students, employees and other interested individuals to answer these questions and many others by accessing PCC data reported to the U.S. Department of Education through the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).

To access data which addresses a broad array of topics, first go to http://nces.ed.gov/collegenavigator/ and enter "Portland Community College" under Name of School. Next click on "Show Results" and the following menu of topics displays.
