PORTLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE and WARNER PACIFIC COLLEGE

To further support and encourage completion of the Baccalaureate and graduate degrees, Portland Community College and Warner Pacific College do hereby agree that students completing the PCC Associate of Applied Science Alcohol and Drug Counselor Program will be admitted to Warner Pacific College with upperdivision rank. It is understood that these students may need to complete additional lower-division general education degree requirements.

Transcripts will be evaluated on an individual basis relative to Core Studies requirements. Transfer classes below the 100 level are not accepted for transfer in Core Studies (except MTH 95 Intermediate Algebra). All grades for transfer must be "C" or better. Students are encouraged to consult an advisor for updated transfer information. Courses in Alcohol and Drug Counseling as described in this agreement are accepted for full college credit under the specific subject matter major programs herein listed.
