## **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

- **EAC Chair Reports:** The AAS math competency language was discussed and is scheduled to move to the EAC as a formal recommendation on 1/29.
- Curriculum Office Updates: None
- Focus Award Guidelines: The committee discussed updated guidelines for new and existing focus awards. Janeen Hull, Chair, shared the proposed changes/updates to the language with members of the committee. If possible, the committee will recommend the proposed changes to the Focus Award guidelines at the January EAC meeting on 1/29.
- Consent Agenda Items: The purpose of consent agenda items was discussed.
  - In the past, the consent agenda was used to aid the Curriculum Office in tracking curricular changes to degrees and certificates that did not involve committee approval/votes.
  - o Going forward, consent agenda items will be described as:
    - Changes to an existing elective list
    - Changing a program from closed entry to open entry
    - Title changes to a degree or certificate
  - Consent agenda items will serve as a notification and will not be voted on by the committee
    - If there are questions about a consent agenda item, the committee reserves the ability to place the item on the agenda for further discussion.

Also, recommended that the SAC review how their degree outcomes are mapped to PCC's core outcomes (committee thinks there are more core outcomes being met than listed here) & and return to the committee in a future meeting for revisions to the outcomes.

- Revision: Website Development & Design AAS: Increasing credits, adding courses, removing courses
  - The committee and faculty represented noticed that there were inconsistencies in the outcomes for the degree.
