- Meetings: The committee will continue to meet at Sylvania for 16-17. Due to remodeling, the meetings will occur in the Tree rooms. More information will be shared as plans are finalized.
- Final meeting of the academic year: Due to a conflict of meeting dates with the EAC and Curriculum, the DAC will continue to hold the final meeting on a Monday. This will allow members to attend EAC and/or Curriculum Committee meeting as needed and it will alleviate the issue of overlapping items.
- Next year's discussion items: The chair reminded the committee that it might consider making time for a possible retreat next year. Possible retreat discussion items could include:
  - A need for involvement or perhaps a separate meeting, once a year to review new courses for a general education program. This would obviously be a joint

- effort with the Curriculum Committee to review the process for approving courses for/to a general education program.
