EAC Report: Eriks Puris

- President Mitsui gave the following updates
 - PCC has been accepted to the Achieving The Dream (ATD) a group from PCC will attend the intake conference in Cleveland in early June.
 - To meet ongoing budget challenges PCC will implement a supplemental budget process
 - Ongoing challenges: responding to gentrification and developing a planning culture.
- Discussion Items
 - S704 Syllabus- rational for what should and should not be on syllabus and how this applies to student request to include a statement about PCC status as a sanctuary college
 - C102 Course Challenge- see prior discussion by Kendra
 - Revised placement process- still early yet, but appears that fewer students feel they are being placed to low, success rates still under review, not clear where this effort with find an institutional home.
 - Student presentation on Social Justice and how it impacts learning at PCC.

Preparation for Gen Ed Retreat on June 30, 2017: Eriks Puris – EAC/LAC integration task force is considering adopting a two pronged approach to assessment

- 1) Courses on General Education List- will be grouped by discipline area and each course within a discipline area will need to address two (or three?) college core outcomes (still to be determined), and will need to have an assignment that will create an artifact that can be scored using a common rubric- ideally by an outside group.
- 2) Each SAC will still create annual assessment projects focused on outcomes of their choosing with the goal of improving instruction.

General discussion highlighted the fact that much remains to be done including which core outcomes will be evaluated by each discipline are and the challenge of assessing every section of a course taught in a single quarter.
