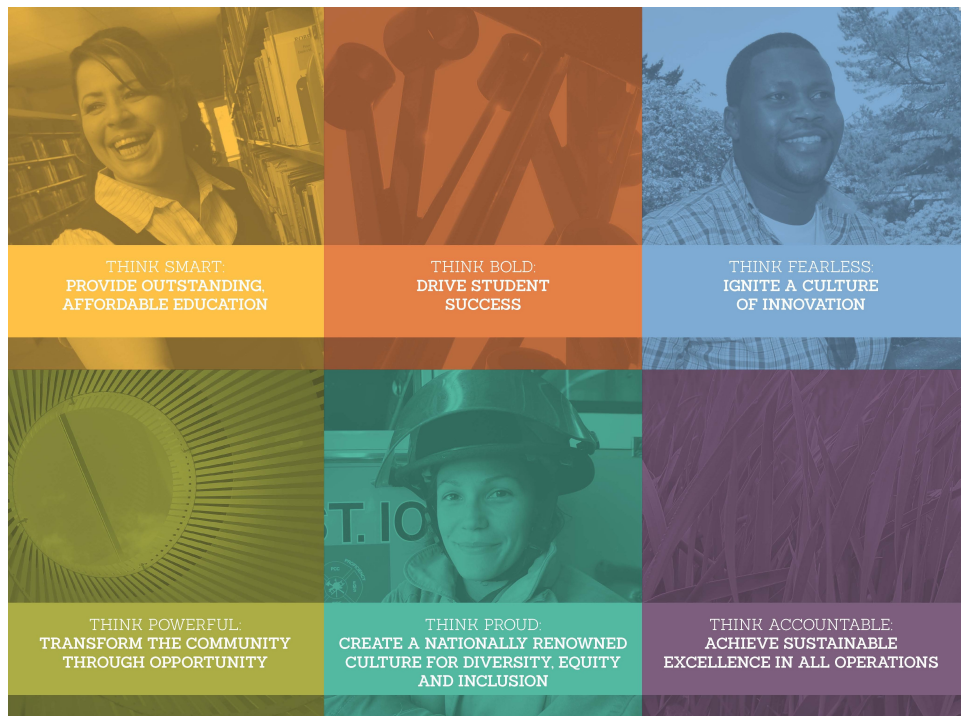

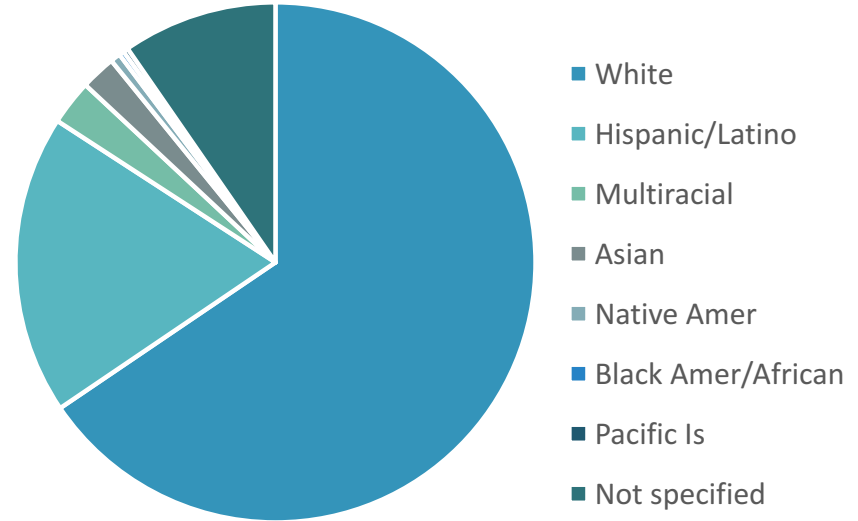

- 170 Female (52.4%)
- 144 Male (44.4%)
- **18%** enrolled in remedial/pre-college classes
- **10%** enrolled in career technical classes
- **73%** enrolled in lower division transfer classes

Enrolled

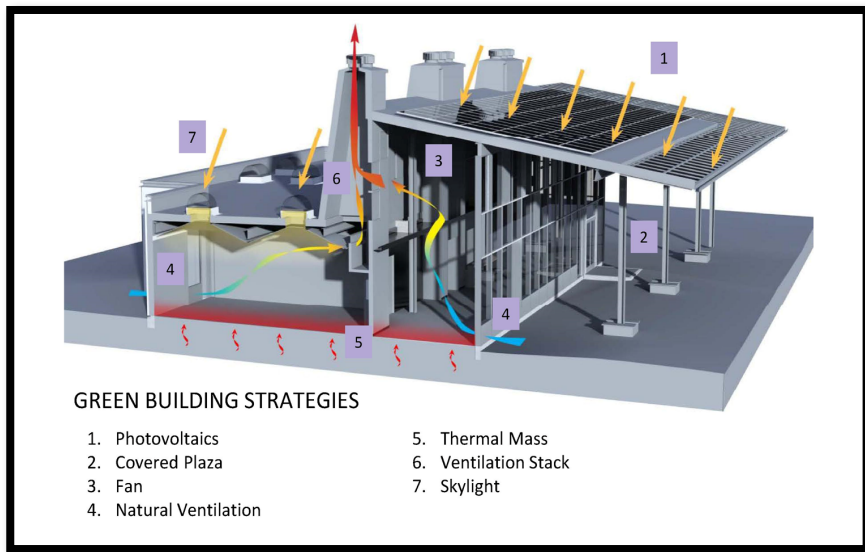
- Part-time (1-5cr) 13.5%
- Half-time (6-11cr) 40.4%
- Full-time (12+cr) 46.2%
- 42.8% are 19 years old or under

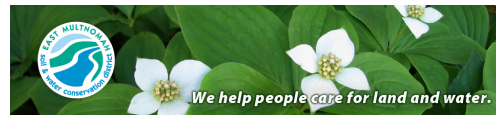

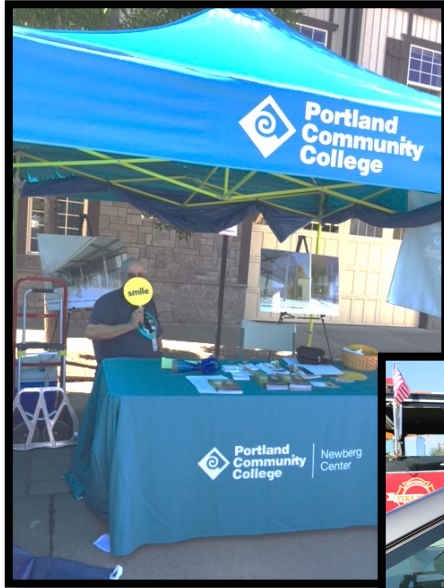
