DOL Apprenticeship Grant Received

PCC received a grant of \$247,500 from the state of Oregon over 2.5 years to expand manufacturing registered apprenticeships including three for OMIC in Machining, Industrial Fabrication and Mechatronics.

Facility Design Build Firm Selected

Mortenson Construction was selected through a competitive RFP process to lead the facility planning and implementation for PCC OMIC facility.

First OMIC Apprenticeship Approved

The Oregon State Apprenticeship and Training Council approved the first OMIC Registered Apprenticeship standards for Machinists. The JATC spent significant time developing these standards for OMIC.

NCATC Provides Tech. Assistance

PCC brought in national workforce agency, National Coalition for Advanced Technology Centers, to host OMIC Training stakeholder meetings and provide recommendations on facility.

PCC will receive final report from NCATC with recommendations on OMIC facility and programming.




