


Net Assets & Endowed Funds

Board Goals 2013-2014

- 1. Strengthen the Foundation Board's fundraising capacity, ability, and results to support scholarship and program needs, other unmet needs, and opportunities.
- 2. Increase gifts over \$25,000 and the number of donors who make increased gifts over time.
- 3. Grow the amount of funds raised to support Future Connect to sustain current financial commitments and ensure program continuation.
- 4. Function as a high-level advisory and fundraising board to the President and ensure that philanthropy supports the College's strategic plan.



2013-14 Fundraising Priorities

- Raise \$2.78 million-a 15% increase
- Award \$1 million in scholarships for the 2014/15 academic year–a 14% increase
- Meet Future Connect matches from the three city partners
- Cultivate new giving in STEM/STEAM partners
- Expand planned giving
- Complete first large-scale alumni phonathon survey
