Counseling Office Records

- Implementing a secure, confidential, and eco-friendly electronic record keeping system would address the issues of inconsistency, inaccessibility, integration with the scheduling system, time requirements, space requirements and supply costs.
- Potential savings nearly \$20,000 per year.

Lotus-Pro Cleaning Process

- This chemical-free cleaning system turns ordinary tap water into Aqueos Ozone-a powerful natural cleaner, stain remover, deodorizer and sanitizer. This eliminates the need for using separate chemical products for different tasks.
- Initial cash outlay is over \$50,000 with a 4-5 year payback period.



Testing and Registration Fees

- Still under review.
- Some students apply for admission to PCC to gain access to placement tests at PCC in order to have these scores forwarded to another college. Then they never attend PCC.

Advertising

- Still under review.
- PCC has no policy on advertising nor do most of our peers.
- Proposals submitted were for advertising on the interior of our shuttles and on toilet paper.

Airport Parking

- Still under review.
- Proposal recommended entering into an agreement with an airport parking company in order to obtain a better parking rate for those times our employees travel

Discount or Incentive Cards

- Still under review. Additional information requested from submitters.
- Potential to return small portion of student fee to PCC.
