REPORT: This project is for the modernization of the Science
Technology Building hydraulic elevator on the Sylvania
Campus. The purpose of this elevator work is to improve
both mechanical and electrical reliability, as well as to
implement new building and fire code improvements.

A formal Invitation to Bid (ITB) was advertised for this project
in the Daily Journal of Commerce and posted on the State
Vendor Information Program on March 20, 2001. ITB
documents were distributed to eleven (11) contractors, one
of which was a certified M/W/ESB firm, as well as to eleven
(11) plan centers. Four (4) bids were submitted by the due
time and date of 10:00 A.M. on April 30, 2001.
