Report: To acknowledge and honor President Daniel F. Moriarty for his 15 years of service and leadership to the college, the Board of Directors has decided to bestow the title of "President Emeritus" to Dr. Moriarty. The board feels this is a fitting legacy for a person whose leadership has done so much to further the development and growth of Portland Community College. The Board further believes that President Moriarty was instrumental in promoting excellence in academics, arts and sciences at all the campuses and expresses its appreciation to him for his perseverance in securing the funds to make the growth of the college a reality.

The Board authorizes President Emeritus Moriarty to use college facilities, to have business cards printed for his use and to have full access to college programs and services for the remainder of his lifetime.

Recommendation: The PCC Board of Directors provide Dr. Daniel F. Moriarty the title of "President Emeritus" and authorize him to use this title in perpetuity.

Director McKinney moved to approve Resolution 02-011 giving Dan Moriarty President Emeritus status. Chair Hereford read the resolution into the record and it passed unanimously.
