REPORT:

On June 21, 2001, the Board of Directors of Portland Community College District approved Resolution 01-113 adopting the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 budget.

The Multnomah County Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission noted that the Student Activities Fund appropriation in the adopting resolution was inadvertently increased by more than the 10% limit set by ORS 294.435. It is therefore necessary to reduce the Student Activities Fund Fiscal Year 2001-02 appropriation to comply with ORS

294.435.

This amendment does not affect the District's property tax levy for the Fiscal Year 2001-2002.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Directors approve this resolution to amend Resolution 01-113 and reduce the Student Activities Fund appropriation for the fiscal year 2001-2002 by the amount outlined in Exhibit A to comply with ORS 294.435.
