REPORT:

The purpose of the supplemental budget is to amend the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 budget and revise the estimated revenues from Federal Sources due to higher than anticipated financial aid grants as a result of enrollment

growth beyond expectations.

The amendments do not require any additional property tax

levy.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Directors approve the supplemental budget amending the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 Budget of the Portland Community College District as outlined in the attached Exhibits "A & A-1".

Whereas, the current economic condition generated an exceptional increase in student enrollment for the college, and

Whereas, as a result, the College has experienced a higher number of applications and awards than expected in student financial aid, and

Whereas, this situation was not foreseen at the time of the preparation of the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 budget and requires prompt action and a change in budget requirements, and

Whereas, in order for the College to meet the demand for services and increase in program activities, it is necessary to amend the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 Adopted Budget to record and reflect the receipt of the additional revenues and appropriate them accordingly to meet program expenditures, and

Whereas, the amendments to the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 Adopted Budget do not require any additional property tax levy and are necessary in order for the College to comply with the requirements of Chapter 294 of the Oregon Revised Statute, now therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the budget for the Portland Community College District for the fiscal year 2001-2002 commencing July 1, 2001 is hereby amended as outlined in Exhibit "A-1".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the President is hereby authorized and directed to amend the Portland Community College District fiscal year 2001-2002 budget as outlined in this resolution.
