REPORT: A new, hosted Parking Management Software System is
needed by the Parking Department to replace the outdated
system currently being used. The new system will issue
citations, permits, download point of sale information, and will
include new hand held ticket writers.

A Request for Proposals (RFP) for a Parking Management
System was advertised in the Daily Journal of Commerce and
on the State of Oregon VIP system on February 19, 2002.
RFP documents were distributed to twenty-two (22) vendors.
Three (3) proposals were submitted, from DataTicket,
Cardinal and T2 Systems, by the due date of March 14, 2002.
Proposals were reviewed by a five-member committee and
evaluated based on the following criteria: Functionality, Cost,
Integration, Vendor Qualifications, System Performance,
Vendor's Vision, Support Services, Customer Performance,
Responsiveness and Partnership. Award will be made to
vendor who received highest total points. Below is a list of
proposals received and total points:

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Directors accept the proposal from, and award a contract to, T2 Systems, Inc., for a Parking Management System in the amount of \$246,807.00. The contract will be for a five (5) year period, with two possible annual renewals, for a total not to exceed term of seven (7) years. Funding will come from Auxiliary Services funds.

Resolutions 02-106 through 02-109 were moved for approval by Director McKinney and it passed unanimously.
