REPORT:

At the October 18, 2001 meeting, per Resolution #02-037, the Board adopted findings, granted an exemption from competitive bidding, and authorized the use of the Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC) contracting method for the Southeast Center Construction

Project.

At the April 18, 2002 meeting, per Resolution #02-093, the Board awarded the CM/GC contract for this project to Baugh Construction Company. The recommendation in that resolution was to bring the actual total construction cost on a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) back to the Board for approval. That GMP amount has been determined to be \$14,313,406 and the Board's approval is hereby requested.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Directors approve the GMP of (not-to-exceed) \$14,313,406 for the CM/GC contract with Baugh

Construction Company for the Southeast Center

Construction Project. All funding for this project will be from

the capital construction fund.
