This certificate program will provide students who currently hold a post-secondary degree, with the opportunity to pursue licensure to become a Certified Alcohol Drug Counselor (CADC) as per the Addiction Counselor and Drug Counselor Board of Oregon (ACCOB). The proposed certificate program course work is aligned with the existing PCC AAS degree program entitled Alcohol and Drug Counselor. Alcohol and drug counselors work in the private and public sectors, provide diagnosis, education, and

resources for referral and treatment.
