REPORT: This program will provide students with a State-approved high school diploma through Portland Community College.

The program will bring the current PCC High School

Completion program and the PCC College Bound program into compliance with the Oregon content and performance standards. The process to develop the diploma included the development of a district-wide plan and the alignment of PCC course outcomes with the State Secondary Standards. The goal of the program is to enable students to earn a high school diploma while earning PCC college credit in order to meet student needs, interests, and goals. PCC credit may be applied to either a certificate of a completion, a two-year

associate degree program, or a transfer degree.
