REPORT:

At the September 17, 1998 meeting, per Resolution #99-

023, the Board awarded a contract to AFSA Data

Corporation (now known as ACS, Inc.) to provide student loan management services. The contract was approved for a five (5) year term and will expire on September 30, 2003. However, since the timing of when the contract will expire coincides with both the Financial Audit and the beginning of Fall Term, the College wishes to extend the contract for four (4) additional months through January 31, 2004. This extension would provide additional time for any transition process of moving existing student loan accounts in case

the new contract was awarded to a different service

provider.

In the meantime, the Financial Services Department will be working on processing a new Request for Proposals for

Student Loan Management Services.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Directors authorize extending the Student

Loan Management Services contract with ACS, Inc.,

through January 31, 2004, which will result in an increase of \$35,000 to the existing contract amount. Expenditures will

be from the General Fund.
