REPORT: This degree program will provide students with an Associate of Science Oregon Transfer – Business degree. The ASOT-Business is a statewide transfer degree that was developed jointly by the community colleges of Oregon and the state OUS universities. The ASOT-Business is similar in concept to the AAOT, however, it allows students to transfer with a designated major and be accepted with junior standing at the receiving institution.

The general education and business requirements have been established at the state level for participating community colleges. The receiving four-year institutions have individually added prerequisites and recommendations for transfer based on the requirements for their university. All seven OUS schools are participating in this agreement. The ASOT-Business has been approved by the Joint Boards of Education, the Oregon Community College Council of Instructional Administrators, and the University Provost Council.

RECOMMENDATION: That the college be authorized to submit an application to the State Board of Education to offer the Associate of Science Oregon Transfer-Business.

A motion was made by Director Germond to approve Resolutions 04-092 through 04-104 and it passed unanimously.
