INCREASE IN STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE FOR FY05

REPORT:

There has been no increase in the student activity fee for seven years. The fee, in part, supports student employment in student government and the hourly employment rates have increased significantly in the last five years. In addition, the cost of programming has grown, and there are increased numbers of students in the new Extended Learning Campus and Southeast Center.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize increasing the student activity fee from \$1.00 to \$1.10 per credit hour.

Director Germond moved to approve Resolutions 04-123 through 04-135, 04-137, and 04-138 by consent agenda and it carried unanimously.
