REPORT:

The degree option and certificate will provide students with the opportunity to pursue specialization with an emphasis in kitchen and bath remodeling and design through the current BCT program. Course work focuses on hands-on residential construction practices, interior design and drafting. Students will participate in internships and professional organizations to enhance training and knowledge. Graduates of the program will seek employment as designers, remodelers, installers, and project managers. Materials and supplies are supported by the National Kitchen and Bath Association

(NKBA), for which PCC is recognized.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the college be authorized to submit an application to the State Board of Education to add an AAS degree option and a two year certificate in Design-Build Remodeling to the existing Building Construction Technology program.
