REPORT: The certificate in Electronic Engineering Technology will be added to the existing AAS degree and will include the first three terms of the program. Students will be able to work in apprenticeship roles at entry-level positions in the electronics industry and are expected to continue taking courses toward the AAS degree while employed. The EET advisory has validated and supports the addition of the certificate. Mt. Hood Community College supports the certificate since they can send students to Portland Community College.

RECOMMENDATION: That the college be authorized to submit an application to the State Board of Education to add a certificate to the AAS in Electronic Engineering Technology program.
