REPORT:

The College and the PCC Federation of Classified Employees (PCCFCE) have engaged in negotiation for a successor agreement since January 2005. A tentative agreement was reached on November 15, 2005. The agreement is for four years, retroactive to July 1, 2005 and expiring on June 30, 2009. Details of the agreement were discussed with the Board in executive session at the December 2005 meeting.

PCCFCE has scheduled a ratification vote by the membership; results of the vote will be announced prior to the Board meeting.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the tentative agreement between the College and the PCC Federation of Classified Employees be adopted by the Board of Directors.
