REPORT:

The proposed degree will allow students to pursue an AAS in Web Development and Design with expertise in either web programming or web design using a multidisciplinary approach. The degree was created based on input from the Web Advisory Committee by identifying skill sets needed by their employees. The need to offer students a specialization within the degree to pursue either a design or development area of expertise also surfaced as a result of the discussion. The degree includes course work from the Computer Applications and Office Systems, Multimedia , Computer Information Systems, and Art departments and was developed in a collaborative design effort. Additionally, the degree is a natural extension of the one-year certificate and an opportunity to develop career pathways in other computer related fields of study as web-related classes at PCC are now experiencing an increase in enrollment. Similar programs have been developed at Clackamas Community College and Clark Community College in Vancouver, WA.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the college be authorized to submit an application to the Oregon State Board of Education for an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Web Development and Design.
