REPORT:

The proposed certificate will provide students with the knowledge and skills needed for entry-level technical work in a correctional setting. The certificate is directed to the initial step in an educational pathway for either the current certificate in Juvenile Corrections or the AAS in Criminal Justice and allows students with a credential to work in the field of criminal justice as they pursue further study.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the college be authorized to apply to the Oregon Department of Education to offer a certificate of completion in Corrections Technician as part of the Criminal Justice Program.
