REPORT:

The certificate of completion is designed for students  
interested in entry-level work requiring foundation skills in  
machine manufacturing. Students can apply course work  
from the certificate to the longer certificates in the  
program or the AAS in Machine Manufacturing  
Technology.

This core group of courses was previously offered as an  
Employment Skills Training certificate; however, the  
college is not permitted to identify the area of study on  
the diploma per state regulations. By formalizing the  
coursework as a stand-alone certificate, the focus of  
study is immediately evident to the employer.

The courses making up the proposed certificate have  
been endorsed by the program advisory board.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the college be authorized to apply to the Oregon  
Department of Education for a certificate of completion in  
Machine Manufacturing Technology: Machine  
Technician.
