AUTHORITY TO INCREASE STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE
FOR THE 2007-2008 ACADEMIC YEAR

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REPORT: The Deans of Student Development, the Council of Presidents of ASPCC and other student leaders have been working on reviewing the student activity fees. A reasonable increase is needed in order to fund increases in student wages. This increase will not exceed \$0.10 per credit. The current rate is \$1.50 per credit hour charged to every credit hour a student enrolls. Among other uses, the funds generated may be used to provide increasing support for student childcare, assist funding student activities programs at the Southeast Center, and to help absorb the impacts of increases in student salaries due to the mandatory increase of the minimum wage in Oregon.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board authorize the District President to increase the student activity fee by up to \$0.10 per credit hour effective Summer 2007. The fee will be charged for every credit hour a student enrolls.
